Yerrabi Yurwang's Empowering Families Program is a free and voluntary service that supports Aboriginal children, young people, and families to thrive by reducing involvement with statutory through early support, systems family preservation, restoration, and aftercare services.

We support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, young people & families who are either:



Experiencing challenges that may place children at risk of entering Out of Home Care (OoHC)

Already involved with the ACT Child Protection and/or Youth Justice (YJ) systems

Working towards restoration where children are currently in OoHC

What We Do

Aged 17-24, who have been in OoHC and need extra support to transition safely into adulthood

Prevention

Early support, strengthening families before crisis

Preservation

Intensive support, helping families stay safely together

Restoration

Targeted support, bringing families safely back together

Aftercare Support

Wraparound support, helping young people transition to adulthood

We advocate for families and help them navigate complex systems like child protection, youth justice, housing, health, and legal services.

We provide wraparound support through case management, specialist referrals, home visits, outreach, parenting programs, safety planning, wellbeing support and practical help. We connect families and community members to Yerrabi's wider supports and services—including our Health Hub, cultural programs, and community groups.
